

Accredited Certification Bodies

- Formally recognized by an independent organization
- Undergo annual audits by their AB
- Must comply with standards
- Demonstrate competence, impartiality and the ability to perform certification activities.





Accredited Certification Body Audits

- Audits will be planned and performed by qualified individuals.
- Auditors will act with impartiality.
- Certification decisions will be made by qualified personnel after a review of audit packages.
- Audits will be conducted in a consistent and predictable manner.
